| Best Music & Media Business Project | This category is for any business-related project, such as an Artist Branding Portfolio, or the documentation of a self-organized event. | Please submit in a common format that can be reviewed by the judging panel with standard-equipment. |
| Best VFX & 3D Art Project | This category is for VFX projects, including digital 3D animations, motion graphics, animated matte paintings, live-action integration, as well as simulation shots, etc. | Video: .mov H.264, 1080p Stills: .jpeg, .tiff, .tga min. 3000 px Further project data on request |
